Gymnasts win top honors at meets

September 28, 2007



EUGENE: Umpqua Valley Gymnastics athletes competed in the National Academy of Artistic Gymnasts Back to School Meet on Sept. 22.

At the Level 6 senior age division, Emily Pennington finished first on the vault, second on floor exercise and managed an all-around score of 34.95. Mariah McGovern earned a 9.175 score on vault and an all-around score of 34.45, and Ashley Elias earned a 9.15 on vault and a 34.05 all-around score.

Kily Gilbert earned a 9.05 score on vault at the Level 6 child division and finished in the all-around top 10. Colleen Winn scored a 9.05 on floor exercise and vault with an all-around score of 34.2.

Aluani Aviles won the floor exercise at Level 4 senior age division. At Level 4 junior, Sierra Levy had an all-around score of 34.3 and Alex Stanley managed a 9.15 on floor and an all-around score of 34.7 to lead their age group.

The team also competed at the America's Best Kids Back with Class meet on Sept. 15. Pennington won the floor exercise and vault with an all-around score of 33.7 and McGovern finished second on the balance beam and floor exercise at Level 6, 12-14 age division.

At Level 6, age 7-11, Gilbert won the floor exercise, was second in vault and uneven bars and second in the all-around scoring at 30.4. At the Level 5, 9-11 age division, Will took second in the floor exercise.

Aliles won the all-around competition with a score of 35.00 in the Level 4, 12-and-up age group, placing first in the vault and second in the uneven bars and floor exercise. Levy won on balance beam and Alex Stanley was second in the event at the Level 4, 10-11 age division.
